FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – DIVING

NO.	QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
1	How many diving opportunities are there per day?	There are two dives a day on most days in all itineraries; subject to sea and weather conditions.
2	How long would each diving opportunity be?	Average dive time is 45 minutes – depending on variables such as air consumption and dive site conditions.
3	What equipment are provided for diving?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BCD (buoyancy control device) • Regulator set • Dive Cylinder • Weight belt & weights • Wetsuit • Fins • Mask • Dive computer • Submersible Pressure Gauge
4	What type of diving certifications do I need?	<p>Any diving certification from a recognized agency is accepted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PADI • SSI • NAUI • BSAC
5	What is the minimum and maximum age for diving?	A minimum age of 10 years is required. For guests over 55 years please provide a medical certificate allowing you to dive.

NO.	QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
6	What are the safety measures taken during each diving experience?	<p>Each dive begins with a comprehensive dive brief including our emergency plan for each dive site. Divers will be escorted by our dive guide and crew who are trained on emergency first response.</p> <p>All divers will be assessed on their experience levels (beginning with our <i>Online Check in</i>).</p> <p>The diving sites offered will cater to the different levels of divers' experience.</p>
7	Would diving be done in open sea or soft areas?	Depending on the dive sites, most sites are close to shore.
8	Do you offer any diving experience for non-certified guest?	<p>Yes, we offer a Discover Scuba Diving experience for guests who would like to try out diving. This will take about 2 hours and a minimum age of 10 is required.</p> <p>You will learn the bases of wearing the Scuba equipment and basic skills and safety rules to explore underwater while wearing it.</p> <p>Do note this is not an actual scuba certification.</p>
